Generally, ICC only collects identifiable information that is specifically and voluntarily provided by a visitor to our site. A visitor to our site may choose to provide this information to register for certain areas of the site or order a publication. When a visitor provides this type of identifiable information to us, we use it solely for the purposes for which it was provided. Our policy is not to share personally identifiable information with third parties, unless required by law, or unless explicitly requested by a visitor. We recognise that your information is valuable and we take all reasonable measures to protect your information while it is in our care. We use small text files called cookies to improve the overall site experience, however, these are not used to track individual visitors to our site. The use of cookies is now standard operating procedure for most Web sites, however if you are uncomfortable with the use of cookies, most browsers now permit users to opt-out of receiving them.
